

### **KEY PROGRAMMES**

### Sanwo-Olu Listens Financial Assistance Programme

Supports vulnerable residents with medical, rent, education, and business aid 2.461 billion naira disbursed to beneficiaries, with a budget of 1.6b naira ongoing interventions for new beneficiaries.

### **Eko Cares (Formerly Sanwo-Olu Cares Programme)**

Launched in 2020 with the theme 'Go Forward, Grow Lagos. Empowered beneficiaries through direct cash for small-scale business startup and FMCG partnership.

#### Mother, Infant and Child Development (MICHD) Programme

Social Intervention- Civic Engagement Initiative Launched in 2020 to provide nutrition support for indigent, vulnerable pregnant women. Reached beneficiaries across the six health districts in Lagos.

### **Snacks for Thought: Lagos State School Feeding Programme**

Launched in 2019 to provide fortified breakfast and juice box for primary school pupils. Student in over 33 schools benefitted.

### The Ideal Child Project

Launched in 2021 to address poor performance, abuse, and antisocial behaviors in public school pupils, sanitary towels distributed through a partnership with Kimberly-Clark.

#### **Handwashing Stations Initiative**

Hands-free wash stations installation in markets, hospitals, and bus stops during the COVID-19 pandemic to encourage public hygiene and disease prevention.

### **KEY PROGRAMMES**

#### **Palliative Food Distribution**

Launched in 2023 to alleviate the effect of fuel subsidy removal. Distributed food packages (rice, beans, and garrl) to vulnerable, elderly, and disabled residents.

### **Senatorial District Advocacy Tours**

Public sensitization on government policies across the three senatorial districts, engaging thousands of residents and distributing educational materials.

### **Community Development Engagement**

Quarterly sessions with Community Development Committees and Associations to promote policy awareness, peaceful coexistence, and grassroots governance.

### **Civic Education and Sensitization Program in Schools**

Launched in 2024 to strengthen civic knowledge and encourage political inclusion among young residents.

### **CitizensGate Mobile App**

Digital feedback system to improve governance responsiveness. Citizens Gate 2.0 launched in 2023 with over 633,662+ users engaged integrated with 100+ Ministries, Departments, and Agencies (MDA).



### **KEY PROGRAMMES**

### **Citizens' Gate Radio and TV Programmes**

Radio launch scheduled for Q4 2024 in English and Yoruba, and TV launch scheduled for April 2025 in English, with plans to include Yoruba in the future, Alims to provide public enlightenment, live responses from MDAs, and civic education for Lagosian.

### **Lagos State Community Champion:**

Champions are the faces of inclusion at the grassroots. They act as bridges between citizens and government. They are trusted messengers, facilitators, and mobilisers, through their works, every Lagosian can experience government in meaningful, tangible ways.

### **Open Consultation Platform:**

The platform was launched June 2025, collaborative system where iindividuals, groups, or stakeholders can share their opinions, feedback, and suggestions and also review certain policies, projects, or decisions of the State government before they are finalized.

### Simplification and dissemination of Lagos State Laws:

An initiative that aims to make the laws of Lagos State easier to understand, more accessible, and widely known to the general public.
